



## **Important Information about the County Of Riverside Workers' Compensation Pharmacy Prescriptions Program**

Dear Valued Provider:

The County of Riverside Workers' Compensation Division has implemented a Pharmacy Benefit Manager Program. This program includes network pharmacies for employees with work related injuries. The effective date for this program was July 9, 2013. As a courtesy we are sending notice to inform and remind our valued providers that pharmacy services for workers' compensation prescriptions are to be processed through EXPRESS SCRIPTS.

Injured workers have received an Express Scripts Pharmacy Card and can fill authorized workers' compensation prescriptions at any EXPRESS SCRIPTS participating pharmacy. Express Scripts is a national retail and home delivery provider of pharmacy services. With Express Scripts service, there is no need for injured employees to receive workers' compensation medication from any other source.

Providers may obtain a copy of the Injury Specific Formularies and a list of participating pharmacies on the County of Riverside Workers' Compensation website at <http://workcomp.rc-hr.com/>. Located on this same site is the First Fill Pharmacy Form. This form is used for injured workers who have a new injury and need medications filled the same day.
