Important Information about your Workers' Compensation Prescriptions

Dear Injured Employee:

Effective **July 9, 2013**, your pharmacy program services for your workers' compensation prescriptions will be through Express Scripts.

New Prescription-Drug ID Card

Your new Express Scripts prescription-drug ID card will be mailed to you shortly. Effective **July 9, 2013**, you should begin using the Express Scripts card at any Express Scripts Workers' Compensation participating pharmacy.

When using the Express Scripts pharmacies, you will pay nothing out of pocket for prescriptions approved for your work-related injury. In addition, no changes are being made to your current prescriptions; only the processing information for your pharmacy to submit to Express Scripts.

Filling Prescriptions at Retail Pharmacies

Beginning **July 9, 2013**, you may fill your authorized workers' compensation prescriptions at an Express Scripts Workers' Compensation participating pharmacy. A list of participating chain pharmacies in your area is included on the back of this letter. In addition, you can call the Express Scripts Patient Care Contact Center number at the number below if you need help locating a network pharmacy.
